- Videos should be 1 -2 minutes long. Maximum length is 3 minutes.
 - Be intentional with your background. Gray or neutral backgrounds are preferred and recommended.
 - Rose-Hulman branded clothing is encouraged. If not, try wearing solid, neutral colors. Avoid complex patterns or bright colors to eliminate distractions.
 - Film your video in a quiet place. Locate an area in your house or office to record your video with limited background noise. If you are unsure, test your video.
 - When recording, film your video vertically.
 - Restate the question or use the memory prompt as the beginning of your statement. Examples:
 - "What is my favorite memory from Rose-Hulman?" My favorite memory is..."
 - "My favorite memory from Rose-Hulman is..."
 - Be yourself and relax! You can film your video as many times as you'd like until pressing submit. Your video will not be shared without your approval.

-
- Quality is key. Submit photos with high resolution, preferably large file sizes.
 - Avoid submitting dark or blurry images.
 - If you're taking a selfie, make sure to capture the image vertically. Gray or neutral backgrounds are preferred and recommended.
 - Rose-Hulman branded clothing is encouraged. If not, try wearing solid, neutral colors. Avoid complex patterns or bright colors.

- Once a video, photo, or testimonial has been submitted, it cannot be edited. Make sure you're happy with the final version before hitting submit.
 - Each video, photo and testimonial will be reviewed internally before shared externally.
