Eligibility:

The Alumni Representative to the Board of Trustees shall have graduated with at least a bachelor's degree from Rose-Hulman. They shall possess the skill set needed to represent the Alumni constituency effectively. They will have a willingness to meet the travel, financial, and time requirements of the position in accordance with Board expectations.

Length of Commitment:

The term of this position is 3 years. It will begin with the Homecoming meeting after selection and continue through the spring meeting of the 3nd year (a total of 9 full Board meetings).

Responsibilities:

As Alumni Representative to the Board of Trustees, you will represent the interests of alumni by sharing the needs, expectations and perspective that you have gained through your communication with the alumni base and your experiences in industry. This representation will be accomplished via:

- Acting as a full voting member of the Board of Trustees
- Attending 3 Board of Trustee meetings per year. Meeting dates are shared approximately 2
 years in advance on the Board of Trustees website. Meetings are typically held Thursday,
 Friday, and Saturday.
 - Fall Meeting On campus

Usually held the Thursday before Homecoming weekend. This will be your first Board of Trustees meeting if selected.

- Winter Meeting Off-site retreat
 - Recent locations: Naples, FL, San Diego, CA, Scottsdale, AZ, Houston, TX Usually in February
- Spring Meeting On campus
- Commencement weekend. Always Memorial Day weekend. All Board of Trustee members, including the Alumni Representative receive an invitation to attend Commencement and walk in the student/faculty/board procession for the ceremony.
- Attend and serve on assigned committee meetings occurring ahead of full board meetings
 either via conference call or in person on campus. The first year of membership on the board,
 new members are encouraged to audit/observe as many of the committee meetings as they
